



Narrative Training Report

GREEN (General Movement for Rural Education & Environment) – a registered voluntary service organisation (NGO – Society) committed for the upliftment of the downtrodden and disadvantaged poor in the living community through adopting awareness creation and skill based Training programs in and around our Theni District Tamilnadu. Since its inception on 1989, it has been worked on the need based, result oriented sustainable program efforts and implementing self employment generation programs there by making positive changes over the lives of the poorer especially the rural women masses and mainstreaming them on the sustainable developmental means in education, environment and health focused perspective.

Women are the vital component of the functioning of the community. They are the pivot of the society. **GREEN** believed this and continuing its service performances on the field of women development and welfare activities cantered with women participants. For achieving its focused vision our **GREEN** has formed them in to women self help groups. Every year we have organized new self help groups among the women and disadvantaged community and make them to use our beneficiaries for their sustainable living.

A special **Trade Related Entrepreneur Development (TREAD)** Activity was initiated by GREEN during the end of the year 2014 – 2015 for the development of rurally backward women community in Chinnamanur Block. This **TREAD** (Trade Related Entrepreneur Development Program for Women Scheme) is supported by the **Ministry of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises MSME**, Govt of India and **CANARA Bank** – **Erasakkanaiyakanur** in Theni District is providing a Micro loan for each trades activity to the women self help group beneficiaries.

The women in this project have gained alternative and integrated opportunity to utilize their local base available resources in order to improve their financial status and for economically sustenance.

We have selected about Four (4) kinds of Trade Activity and providing Skill based development Training on it and a **Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP)** under this project. In total about 665 women from the Women Self Help Groups promoted by GREEN are benefited through this program. This program facilitated a course of Training programs on the given trade activities to the women beneficiaries.

And the Training programs are monitored by the **CANARA BANK**, **Erasakkanaiyackanur** Branch along with Micro Credit Linkages to the successful trainees of this project. The below is the report of the same.

The Inauguration of this **TREAD Scheme 2014 – 2015** and its adjoining Training program was started by April 2015 at GREEN's Training Hall located in Erasakkanaiyakanur, Theni with over 665 women beneficiaries and others participated. This training was conducted for about 90 days (for and about 3 months) for each trade activity for more than 468 hrs including practical demos.

Mr. P.S. Bose, Secretary to GREEN and Chief Training Officers of the organisation gave welcome speech and honor the chief guest of the program. He also explained the necessity of self employment, skill development and essential features of the training program. The women beneficiaries must utilise this great opportunity to develop their livelihoods and should stand their own leg he stressed.

Then, Mr. Venkatramana, Asst General Manager (AGM) from NABARD, Theni District and the local village Panchayat President of Erasakanaiackanur villages and members were participated in the inauguration program by lighting the lamp and gave special address as guest lecture.

During his speech, he explained the salient features of the Entrepreneurship Development Training (EDP) Program conducted by the **TREAD Scheme 2014 - 2015** could be more beneficial to the rural women living in the Below Poverty Line in and around of Theni District. He also explained the functional operation of the **NABARD** and the step by step implementation of the EDP Training program.

This program has very significance model in several districts and Theni would be a Best Model and he seeks the fullest cooperation and continual participation of the students during the upcoming training events. He also explained the certification, evaluation process and other back end supports of this training event to be given by the GREEN organisation under this TREAD Scheme.

GREEN Society and the Team of Staffs and Volunteers have coordinated the program events. Under this Training the 665 women beneficiaries has availed the training benefits through the appropriate models and criteria on the selected Trade Activity and the EDP Training program and they will also supported by the Micro Credit Assistances for starting their economic activity.

Before starting the program, we have provided orientation training and the Terms and Conditions of the Training as bellow manner.

- 1. Training were held in their locality
- 2. Practical Demonstration on the Products are conducted for each Trade Activity
- 3. The Training hall was well arranged and organised
- 4. Supported through necessary infrastructure facilities (Chair, Light & Water)
- 5. Trainees attended the class regularly and writing notes
- 6. Orientation and EDP Training is first conducted
- 7. Selected Trainer conduct the class on selected Trades based Training
- 8. One Trainer for One Trade has been followed
- 9. Trainer method & Trainee method of interaction were organised
- 10. Doubts were clarified in the time of Training
- 11. Individual care and attention provided to each Trainee during the Training session
- 12. Exposure visit arranged for each Trade activity on possible ways

Apart from all of this, the trainees were supported through motivation classes, encouraged by playing games, business counseling, success stories and case studies. Suitable examples were also made in their living locality and this were highly encouraged and getting knowledge exposure to them.

During the Inauguration of the TREAD Program, Mr. Venkatramana – Asst. General Manager (AGM) of NABARD, Theni District visited the project activities and gave his valuable suggestions and guidance to implement it effectively. Further he gave a special lecture on Rural Women Entrepreneurs and motivated them for economical empowerment.

❖ CANARA BANK – MANAGER Visited The Training Program

While the implementation of phase wise Training Program, Mr. Mahendran – Branch Manager from CANARA BANK, Erasakkanaiyackanur Branch, Theni has made a direct spot visit of the Training program conducted by TREAD Scheme and he made interaction with the resource persons, monitor the facilities and supports provided to the beneficiaries under the TREAD scheme, functions of various machineries involved in teaching of training subjects, talking with women beneficiaries etc., He well appreciated and encouraged the Training program organized and well implemented by the GREEN organisation.

- ❖ Each Trade Activity based Training has been taught through the specially designed the course curriculum, developed by our team of experts in the GREEN Training Institute which covers all the related matters of the trade topic.
- ❖ Direct Exposure visits to the respective Trade Activity have also been made to the trainees for better knowledge exposure.
- ❖ The women beneficiaries have attended the **demonstration classes** of the products on each Trade Training and are doing well and got practical knowledge exposures on it.
- ❖ Special orientation Classes on Loan Facilities, Bank Procedures, Project Report and how to establish their Own Trade Unit were also conducted.

This training focused to develop the rurally deprived women in BPL families on making technologically sound to acquire self employment opportunity and regular income through the EDT training on the above mentioned trade activity under the **TREAD Scheme**.

Events of the Training

During the implementation of the **GREEN's TREAD Scheme 2014 - 2015**, the following events were held as per the detailed mentioned in the project proposal.

EDT Training Course Content conducted

The following topics were covered during the Entrepreneurship Development Training Program EDP on the selected trade activities for the Training program. At the first 7 days of the training program was conducted for the EDP curriculum with the detailed session on the following topics

- About Entrepreneurship and the Importance of Entrepreneuring
- Who is a real Entrepreneur and
- Qualities & Charactership of Entrepreneurs
- Types of Business and selection of business
- Selection of Raw Materials and quality standards
- Using Man, Material Resources properly
- Women & Business opportunities and livelihoods
- Women & Economic Empowerment
- Rural Women and Young Entrepreneurs
- Market Supply & Demand
- Marketing Opportunity & Marketing Strategy
- Business Management and its Nature of keeping Records & Documents
- Bank Loan procedures and Project Report Preparation etc.,

Apart from this he has also explained the details of value added products and how we can make in the value added products in marketing.

Finally the women beneficiaries were supported the session on Packaging of Products and Labelling it for Marketing. The group discussion and feedback sessions were also made to the training beneficiaries at the end of the training.

Apart from this, the trainer provided a detailed session about the various Government Schemes, KVIC subsidy schemes, DIC schemes and the other Bank Loans that are helpful to the women beneficiaries to establish their own trade unit formation and Income generation activities on this Trade based venture of the selected Trade activities promoted by this TREAD Scheme 2014 – 2015.

SIMPLE HOUSEHOLD CLEANING ITEMS PREPARATION

The selected women beneficiaries of TREAD project undergone the 90 days (3 months) training on preparation of Simple household cleaning items such as Soap oil, Phenayl, Bleaching Powder, Detergent Soap, Soap Powder etc., Resource persons from the reputed institution provided the details of nature and activities of various chemicals involved in household cleaning items preparation, difference between Acids and Alkalines, detailed method of preparation several household cleaning items, making of Detergent Soaps etc., Further he explained the precautionary and safety procedures to handle the chemical items while preparation of various products. Demands and Marketing techniques of it etc.,

This Training was conducted for 3 months. Each of the women participants of this Trade Training involved in making of products at their own. The Trainer – Trainee method of demonstration was conducted. The Trainer gives the practical demonstration on making the product and then the Trainee themselves involved to do it on their own. Doubts were clarified the trainer during the Trainee involved in making it. By this way, the Trainee can gained direct knowledge exposure, improved self-confidence to make the product.

DISPOSABLE PAPER CUP / PAPER BAGS MAKING

As a theme based organization, GREEN trying to make a clean and green environment in the living locality and we are involving the environmental & nature resources, conservation activities since its inception 1989. Till then, we are promoting awareness on Environment and eco-friendly activities; one such is to providing Training to the women on making eco-friendly products. Under this TREAD Scheme 2014 – 2015, we are providing trade based skill development training on Disposable Paper Cups, Tea Cups and Paper Bag/ Wedding Bags, Paper Covers Making Training to the rural women SHGs. In this training we have demonstrated the various types of Paper Bags and adverse effect of using the polythene bags. Paper based handicrafts items and some items of Origami (i.e the Paper Crafts) and Commercial Paper Bags, Festival Paper Bags etc., Further we have encouraged the women groups for utilizing the Paper bags instead of Polythene bags.

LOW COST - SANITARY NAPKIN MAKING

As a part of the TREAD Scheme 2014 – 2015, we have conducted a "Low Cost- Hygienic – Sanitary Napkin" to the rural young mothers and the members of the SHG federation covered in the working area. In this Training, the reputed resource providing the direct focuses of Rural Women's Health issue and Menstrual hygiene especially in practices of using the menstrual pads during the period. Then she demonstrated the Low Cost, Home Made, Hygienic Sanitary Napkin preparation by using Semi – Automatic Sanitary Napkin Making M/c. The participants, particularly young mothers have been observed closely the demonstration of the Sanitary Napkins and known the functional operation of the Machine. She also imparts the proper disposal of the napkin pads after use by using the Mechanical Sanitizer. This was very useful to the rural women population.

She also provides the Pictorial Demonstration of 28 Days Cycle of Menstrual and Hygiene practices, Safe sex practices etc. and showed the picture about the process and preparation method of using Sanitary Napkins. An awareness notices about the Rural Women's Health Issue was distributed to the participants.

This Training was conducted for 3 months. Each of the women participants of this Trade Training involved in making of products at their own. The Trainer – Trainee method of demonstration was conducted. The Trainer gives the practical demonstration on making the product and then the Trainee themselves involved to do it on their own. Doubts were clarified the trainer during the Trainee involved in making it. By this way, the Trainee can gained direct knowledge exposure, improved self confidence to make the product.

READYMADE GARMENTS PRODUCTION

Under the TREAD Scheme for women we have supported the women SHGs through Trade based skill development training on Readymade Garments production. The selected women beneficiaries of this trade involved in 3 months training (90 days) process on basic Tailoring, understanding the methods of stitching, modern dress making etc., The experienced and certified resource person from the reputed organisation has provided the in class room training on this Readymade Garments Production, History of cloths, ornamentation works on fabrics and readymade garments Aari, Zardosi works, making fashion designing works on readymade cloths etc.,

During the training, each Trainee has supported to used the Tailoring machine, and a resource materials to do the practical works effectively.

This EDP and Trade Skill Development Training provided the various methods of Modern Dress making, Ornamental designs on Garments and success women entrepreneur, leadership qualities, selection of trade, business procedures, and marketing assessment and entrepreneurship development initiatives. This helped to improve their skills on trade based trainings and would provide economical gain through establishing their trade on this activity in future.

This Training was conducted for 3 months. Each of the women participants of this Trade Training involved in making of products at their own. The Trainer – Trainee method of demonstration was conducted. The Trainer gives the practical demonstration on making the product and then the Trainee themselves involved to do it on their own. Doubts were clarified the trainer during the Trainee involved in making it. By this way, the Trainee can gained direct knowledge exposure, improved self-confidence to make the product.

Exposure Visit – Industrial Tour

After completion of the Training, all the women beneficiaries were took for Exposure visit to the nearest area at where the related industries are functioning. The women beneficiaries were visited the industrial exposure and it enhanced their practicall knowledge exposure and know how technology on their related trade activities.

The women beneficiaries trained at Readymade Garments production unit were undertook at the Readymade Garments production unit located in SIDCO Industrial Area @ Kappalur, Madurai District and the Gandhigram Rural Industry @ Gandhigram Dindigul District were visited, the women trained at Sanitary Napkin were visited the Production unit at Theni District itself.

During the Exposure visit all the women trainees were participated eagarely and involved to know how technology on the machineries operations, marketing techniques, quality production and services on their related trades.

By the end of August 2015 the Training Program of the TREAD Scheme 2014 – 2015 was concluded by Secretary to the GREEN organisation and with the valedictory function the training was conducted.

Further the implemented organisation, **GREEN** has referred to the women beneficiaries of the project to avail Bank Loans, Micro Credit Linkages through the support of **CANARA BANK** – **Erasakkanaiyackanur Branch Theni District** to establish their own Trade Unit for their economical sustenance.
